

- Spray fruit trees and other plants with scale insect infestations with dormant or horticultural oil
  to control the sucking insects on the leaves and trunks. Citrus, euonymus, and stone fruit are
  often attacked.
- Mow the leaves on your lawn to speed up decomposition. The organic material is valuable for the lawn and can also be used for mulch or compost.
- Red, white and blue Bluebonnet transplants are available from some retailers. Plant them for a
  display or to begin a naturalized planting in full sun. If the red and white transplants are isolated
  from the blue, and blue seedlings are rogued, the red and or white will produce their unique
  color longer.
